Unfortunately, although we referred our families to the Edb website on the first day of the enforced closure, it was not very clear or regularly updated and as a consequence, some parents were very confused. We would like to clarify once again that, as a registered school, we are not able to take an independent decision to either close or reopen classes, and can only follow the instructions of the Education Department as we receive them. We have, as a result of the confusion, already reviewed our communication system for any sudden enforced closure in the future. This should ensure we are able to contact all parents by both SMS and email as soon as we hear any news or updates from the Education Department. Thank you all for your understanding.
