Please be aware that failure to give sufficient notice may render the Autumn term fee payable in full and result in the forfeiture of the fee deposit.

Supervised Lunch

The lobby area outside the lift is designated for use as a waiting area only for parents, carers and children before classes. Increasingly it is being used as a lunch/eating area for both adults and children throughout the day and we must emphasise this is not a suitable place to eat. We ask that food no longer be consumed in this area. Please also note that food should not be consumed anywhere on the staircase leading up to the lobby. Please inform your helpers of this policy which is for both health and safety reasons and thank you for your cooperation.

If your child needs to eat lunch before or after a session they must eat either off the school premises or in school in a classroom at the table where we can offer a supervised lunch session with a teacher. We can offer the following between 12.10 and 1.00pm (for children aged 2 1/2 up) if you require your child to eat before going home or before starting an afternoon session.
